
## **Getting a Haircut**


I will go to a salon or barber shop to get my hair cut. This is a new place! I am safe in the salon or barbershop with Mom or Dad.

There might be other people there to get their hair cut too. There will be lots of chairs, mirrors, and people talking. Mom or Dad will come with me to the chair that I sit in.






I will sit in a big chair and wear a long cape over my clothes. It's a like a super hero cape! I will be able to see myself in the mirror.

When the hairdresser is done cutting my hair, she will take off the cape. I can look in the mirror and see my new haircut! My hair will look different. This is ok!






